

Potential sites

- Australian sites (security issues primarily preventing the initiation of a data flow)
- Dakar (communication with LC restarted but not a clear way forward yet)
- Punta Arenas (launching RS41 manually, once per day, working to apply soon)
- ESO site
- Puerto Rico/Barbados (launching manually RS41, twice per day, discussion in progress with US NWS, non funding for the SHC)

Other sites under consideration

- Mexico/Indonesia (colleagues from Meisei are in touch with local representatives)
- Namibia (DWD to setup a BSRN station)
- Kazakisthan (no contacts yet, it is an initial idea to further explore after ICM-16)
