- How do we tell if a site is meeting GRUAN requirements?
- Who should ultimately be responsible for certifying and assessing sites?
- How do we manage the process of expanding the network?
 - Consideration of site nominations received
 - Assessment of where we would like sites

Assessment and certification

- Who should have ultimate responsibility?
- How often to assess existing sites?
- Need transparency and objectivity and broad sign-on.

Possible criteria (finite list)

- Adherence to GRUAN protocols and requirements
- Data quality (GRUAN uncert. Measure)
- Operational standards
- Metadata completeness
- Traceability
- Management of changes
- Temporal sampling
- Commitment to and funding for long-term measurements

Expansion

- Scientific assessment
- Current capabilities assessment
- Funding assessment
- Analysis of tabled offers against a set of agreed criteria that is transparent.

GRUAN Imp Plan says

- Set up a site certification and expansion team at this meeting and agree its remit.
- Agree a protocol for site offers arising in the interim at this meeting
- Define assessment criteria by 2011
- Create a priority expansion list by 2012
- Develop operational capability to undertake site assessment by 2013
- Meeting to elicit formal participation (to include existing sites) – GRUAN grand launch as a fully fledged network 2013
