ICM-8 Important Follow-Up Information

If you are a US citizen and plan to participate in the site visits to NOAA and the NCAR Research Aviation Facility on Thursday April 28th **your name must be in our security clearance database**. SuperShuttle recently changed its transportation services between DIA and the Boulder area, eliminating their most affordable shared van service. Now their least expensive service is a non-stop van for 1-3 persons which costs \$84 for the group. If you reserve for 2 or 3 people the per-person cost is reasonable, but if you are traveling alone the cost is now quite high. My apologies if this change has caused anyone problems.

You can toggle between the schedules for Saturday, Sunday and Weekdays, from DIA to Boulder (Westbound) and from Boulder to DIA (Eastbound). Just make sure you are looking at the correct (old or new) schedule based on the date of your arrival.

Meeting registration will begin at 8:00 AM on Monday morning inside the Flatirons meeting room. When registering you will need to pay for lunches and the conference dinner if you plan to partake of these meals (costs are given below). **Payments must be made on Monday morning, in US currency, cash only.** Please try to have the exact amount of your payment in hand. Receipts will be issued as payment is received and can be configured for your needs (e.g., if you need separate receipts for each lunch we can do that).

The meeting will begin promptly at 8:50 AM so please take care of registration and meal payments well in advance. Again, registration will begin at 8:00 AM, so you can even register and then return to your hotel room if needed. The Flatirons room is accessed through the breakfast area, in a separate building from the main part of the Boulder Inn.

Lunches will be served at the Boulder Inn on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday. On Thursday lunch will be served in the NOAA building. **The cost of lunch is \$12 per day (\$60 for the week). Pre-payment of lunches is required on Monday morning.** If you are not attending the meeting Monday morning but would like to sign up for lunch on other days, please send this information to Dale.Hurst@noaa.gov by noon on Monday April 25th.

The **conference dinner will be held Thursday evening at 7:30 PM** at Carelli's of Boulder, an upscale Italian restaurant. The restaurant has a website at <http://www.carellis.com/>. Carelli's is a 3-minute walk from the Boulder Inn. **The cost of this dinner, including limited wine, is \$50 per person.
